God doesn't ask us to win the battle but to simply be strong and courageous. As Joshua is about to enter the Promised Land with Israel, God reminds him to be "strong and courageous." To be precise, God uses the phrase "Be strong and courageous," four separate times. Any repetitive wording from God should not be ignored, and if God repeats a phrase four times, you better take notice! I wonder how often God wants to tell us, "Be strong and courageous." Today, in the midst of everything, remember those words given to Joshua. For today, you may have the opportunity to enter the Promised Land.

Read Joshua 1:1-9

1. Based on the video you just watched, what stood out most to you?
2. Describe a time a change was needed in your life and yet you struggled to move from the past.
3. Why is the unknown so intimidating?
4. Read Romans 8:31. Paul reminds the Church, if God is for us then no one can be against us, no matter how big they are!
5. Describe the comfort in knowing God is with you on the journey.
6. Discuss a time you stepped out in faith and trusted God to move in a powerful way.
7. Based on this discussion, what do you need to do differently this week?
